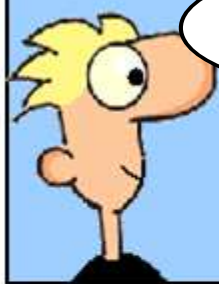

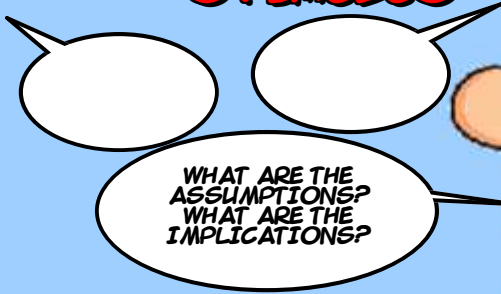
CONSUMERISM IS BAD FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

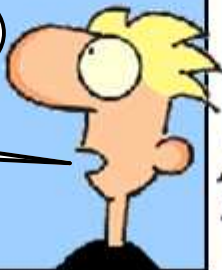

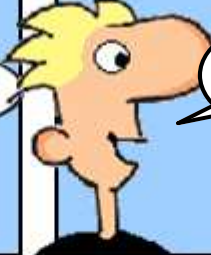

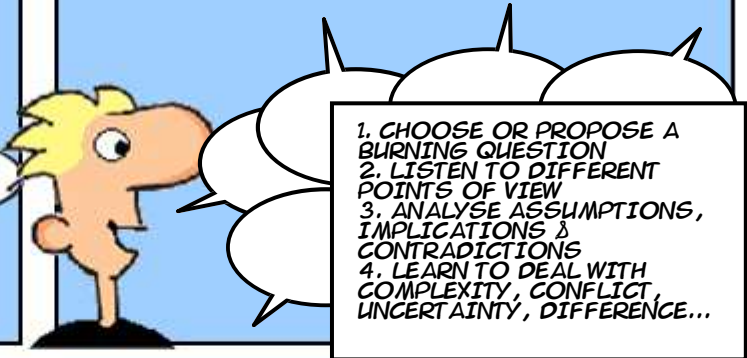
REFLEXIVE QUESTIONS
